WHAT The City of Dallas is hosting a public forum to explore two possible amendments to the Dallas Development Code:

- New parking requirements for outdoor restaurant, bar, and entertainment areas; and
- A late-hours overlay designed to regulate personal service and retail uses that operate late at night.

When the business community later became aware of the meeting and inquired with city staff, city officials changed course and opened this meeting to those most affected by these possible amendments ... and Save the Patio was born.
